Bobbing for Apples

- Open to Grades K-8
- Cost: \$2.00
- Registration will be limited to 10 participants per session. First come, first served depending on when completed entry form, parent waiver, and fee is received.
- A large tub will be filled with water. Apples will be floated to cover the surface.
- Using only their mouths, contestants try to grab apples with their teeth.
- No hands or utensils may be used. Hands must be kept behind each contestants back
- The first contestant to grab an apple in their mouth in 3 minutes or less wins.

Chocolate Pie Eating

- Open to Grades 6-8
- Cost: \$5.00
- Registration will be limited to 10 participants per session. First come, first served depending on when completed entry form, parent waiver, and fee is received.
- No hands or utensils may be used. Hands must be kept behind each contestants back.
- The first contestant to finish his/her whole pie and stand up will be declared the winner! Winners will be determined by the judges.
- In the event of a tie – more than one first place winner will be selected.
- If a contestant throws up or regurgitates, he or she will automatically be disqualified.

Hula Hoop Contest

- Open to Grades K-8
- Cost: \$2.00
- Hula Hoops will be provided – but if you have your own, bring it!!!
- Awards given to the longest time with one hoop and The farthest walked while hula hooping.

- Open to Grades 6-8
- Cost: \$5.00
- Registration will be limited to 10 participants per session. First come, first served depending on when completed entry form, parent waiver, and fee is received.
- No hands or utensils may be used. Hands must be kept behind each contestants back.
- The first contestant to finish his/her whole donut and stand up will be declared the winner!
- In the event of a tie – more than one first place winner will be selected.
- If a contestant throws up or regurgitates, he or she will automatically be disqualified.
