FREE Spay & Neuter Mobile Clinic

Thursday, November 6th at 8am

[The Peninsula Human Society & SPCA](#) is offering a free mobile spay/neuter clinic for families/pet owners with limited financial means to fix their pets, helping to eliminate the possibility of accidental litters.

- Pets will be accepted from 8am-9am on a first come, first served basis.
- Surgery is performed by a licensed vet inside the Peninsula Humane Society's surgery vehicle.
- One pet per family; dogs and cats only; no dogs over 80lbs and no pets over 8 years old.
- Pets must fast from midnight on the night before the surgery and be current on vaccinations. Pets may drink water after midnight.
